ROLE AND PURPOSE

The Samplers are responsible for the sampling/collecting process samples at various sample points in the Marampa Process Plant. They also prepare samples for analysis by following standard operating procedures (SOPs), which may involve dilution, filtration, extraction, or other sample-specific treatments.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collecting samples in the Process Plant at various identified points.
- Ensure that the exchanging of sample buckets is done correctly and appropriately.
- Ensure that sample buckets are properly cleaned after every exchange.
- Correctly identify sample buckets with submission sheet accordingly checked.
- Effectively communicate and coordinate activities with colleagues and other relevant personnel to address concerns.
- Always adhere to all Safety, Health, and Environmental protocols and regulations.
- Perform routine checks on equipment and immediately report any malfunctions or abnormalities to the supervisor onsite.
- Ensure the proper labelling, identification, and documentation of collected samples, including date, time, location, and any relevant information.
- Maintain and clean sampling equipment, ensuring that they are in good working condition to avoid cross-contamination and inaccurate results.
- Perform routine equipment calibration and verification as required.
- Record sample data and results accurately in laboratory notebooks or electronic systems.
- Generate reports and share findings with laboratory analysts, scientists, or other stakeholders.
