The purpose of this role is to conduct mine surveys to provide accurate spatial data for the planning and operational activities of the mining project. This role involves both fieldwork and, in the office, to ensure that the mine's operations are aligned with legal, safety, and environmental regulations.

### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Conduct detailed and accurate surveys of mining sites.
  - Create and maintain accurate maps and plans for mining operations.
  - Use surveying instruments (total stations, GPS, and level instruments) to collect data.
  - Setting out pit designs, drill and blast hole patterns to support pit operations.
  - Support exploration and drilling campaigns by setting out and surveying drill hole collars.
  - Plan and execute ariel surveys with drones to update pits, stockpiles and tailings dam facilities.
  - Monitoring pit wall slope.
  - Work closely with engineers, geologists, and other mining professionals to ensure that surveying data supports project goals.
  - Supervise survey foremen, technicians and chainmen.
  - Ensure all surveying activities comply with relevant mining regulations, safety standards and environmental guidelines.
  - Ensure adherence to all health and safety protocols to foster workplace safety for all.
  - Contribute and participate in safety training, risk assessments and safety audits.

- Proficiency in Microsoft Office Suites (Office, Outlook, Teams etc).
- Detail oriented.

### **WORK ENVIRONMENT AND PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS**

- Involves working in variable weather conditions and challenging terrains during fieldwork.
- May involve extended work hours including weekends, holidays, and shift rosters.
- Office-based tasks may involve working in confined spaces and long hours of sitting.
