ROLE AND PURPOSE

Marampa Mines Limited seeks to recruit an ambitious and enthusiastic Junior Mining Engineer. The Junior Mining Engineer will support the development and implementation of effective mining plans and strategies aimed at optimizing production while ensuring safety and compliance with all relevant HSE policies, procedures, and regulations. The role will focus on assisting with short-, medium-, and long-term mining operations and will require close collaboration with various teams, including senior engineers, geologists, surveyors, contractors, and production personnel. The Junior Mining Engineer will be responsible for daily production planning, blending options, data management, and equipment optimization while maintaining efforts that promote zero harm within our mining operations.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure adherence to HSE policies, procedures, objectives, and regulations, with a strong commitment to achieving zero harm through safe behaviours.
- Actively support safety initiatives and work in compliance with health, safety, and environmental standards.
- Develop and maintain a daily production plan, including a 2-week rolling plan, taking into consideration equipment capacities and production constraints.
- Evaluate blending options for different mining scenarios to maintain optimum ore processing and supply to crushers.
- Work closely with the Mining Engineer, Chief Mining Engineer, Operations Superintendent, and Mining Contractors to ensure alignment with operational goals and effective plan execution.
- Regularly consult with the Senior Surveyor, Senior Mine Geologist, and the production team regarding any changes to pit and dump designs.
- Support the contractor in adjusting mining strategies based on evolving project needs.
- Contribute to the development of mining plans that align with short, medium, and long-term strategies and objectives.

- Ensure that pit and dump designs are in line with technical, safety, and environmental requirements.
 - Manage mining-related data, ensuring its accuracy and availability for planning purposes.
 - Oversee data-capturing personnel to ensure timely and precise recording of operational data.
 - Assist with equipment optimization to improve mining efficiency and output.
 - Efficiently plan and manage ore stockpiles to ensure a continuous and uninterrupted supply of ore to crushers with minimal downtime and delays in processing.
 - Regularly update pit and dump engineering designs and make them available with all technical specifications and safety requirements.
 - Regularly update block models for use in planning processes.
 - Effectively deputise the Mining Engineer, providing support and assuming additional responsibilities in his/her absence.
 - Perform other duties and responsibilities as assigned by the immediate Supervisor to ensure the effective and efficient operation of mining activities.
