- Generate reports for management highlighting performance, incidents, or deviations.
- Keep records updated for audits and operational reviews.
- Monitor operations to ensure adherence to safety regulations and site procedures.
- Participate in safety meetings and contribute to hazard identification and mitigation strategies.
- Monitor key performance indicators (KPIs) like haul truck utilisation, load factors, cycle times, and equipment availability.
- Produce shift, daily, and weekly reports to assist with production analysis and operational planning.
- Record and report equipment breakdowns, delays, or safety incidents.
