Position Summary

Your responsibilities will encompass several key credit functions, including conducting credit evaluations of both local and international vendors, preparing credit proposals, and ensuring compliance with credit policies and established credit limits.

The ideal candidate will also play a role in managing the company's credit insurance program and will conduct due diligence (Know Your Customer/KYC) on counterparties to ensure that all credit risks are thoroughly assessed and mitigated.

Key Responsibilities

- Conduct comprehensive credit reviews and prepare credit proposals for both local and international vendors to support informed decision-making.
- Analyze financial data, market information, and vendor documentation to identify potential credit risks and determine appropriate credit limits and payment terms.
- Monitor credit exposures to ensure compliance with established credit limits and company credit policies and promptly escalate issues or delays to relevant stakeholders.
- Prepare and submit weekly and monthly credit exposure reports to senior management, providing clear insights into current and emerging risks.
- Support the management of credit risk mitigation measures, including participation in the administration of the credit insurance program.
- Review and contribute to the enhancement of credit risk-related policies and procedures to strengthen overall risk management practices.
- Collaborate closely with the Supply Chain and Accounts Payable teams to obtain necessary documentation and ensure accuracy in credit assessments.
- Assist in assessing KYC applications and maintaining databases of local and international counterparties, including suppliers, customers, warehouses, and shipping companies.



Qualifications and Experience

- A Bachelor's degree (equivalent/higher qualification) in Finance, Economics, Accounting, Business Administration, or a related field is required.
- Professional certification, such as ACCA, is an added advantage.
- The ideal candidate should have at least 7-10 years of experience in credit risk management, preferably gained within a trading house or a banking environment.
