- Analyse and interpret data from the SCADA system to detect any potential or existing problems.
- Prepares trends to detect abnormalities or deviations from KPI's.
- Maintain, troubleshoot, and recover SCADA systems as necessary.
- Coordinate with engineering sections to resolve any technical issues in a timely manner.
- Manage all SCADA controls in all sections.
- Implement changes to the SCADA system as required by changes in the operational environment- KPI's
- Communication streamline between mining operations and Plant
- Monitor and control all operational equipment.
- Ensure plant operations are maintained within operating parameters.
- Communicate with all departments within the facility to ensure safe and efficient execution of daily plant activities.
- Document all operational and maintenance activities for future reference and auditing.
